Stakeholders Feedback and Action Taken Report for the AY 2020-2021

Actions taken on 2020-2021 Feedback

- Due to the Pandemic the colleges were instructed to work online.
- Faculties were extended the support to prepare the subject videos for the students.
- Each video was checked by the principal madam and other authorities and then it was sent to the students.
- Post viewing of the videos, special doubt sessions of the faculty were kept where the students interacted with the faculties

- Course Coordinators were asked to review the syllabus where ever required to reduce the gap between World Global Fashion Scenario and Academics.
- Faculties were asked to suggest the name of books as per the new latest edition in the syllabus as reference books. E Books and Forecasts were provided to the students.
- Course Coordinators were suggested to add more value added courses in the syllabus.
- Learning Management System for student's interaction was upgraded.
- Smart Class rooms, Video conferencing, Google meet etc. was made effective by use of ICT in the Pandemic
- Skill Assessment exercises was given to the students. This helped them to understand their strong and weak skillsets.
