- Exam results would be published online and Students can get their marks & progress report form Mobile App or Web Portal.

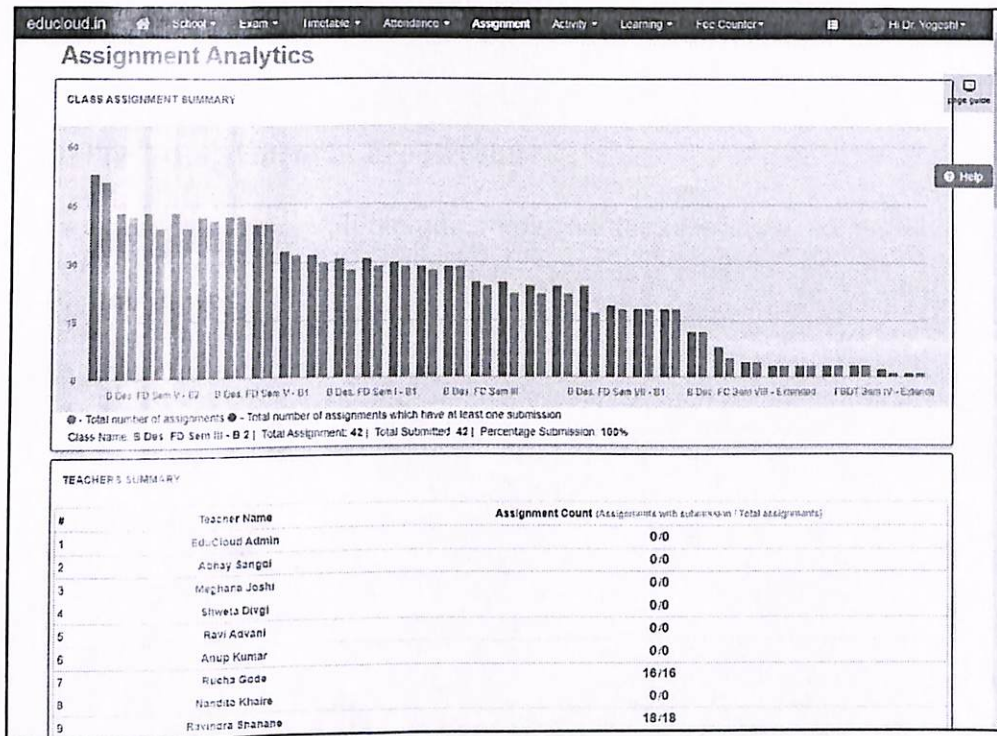
8. Online Fee Payment & Fee Receipt

- Students can see all the upcoming and due fees and make online payment.

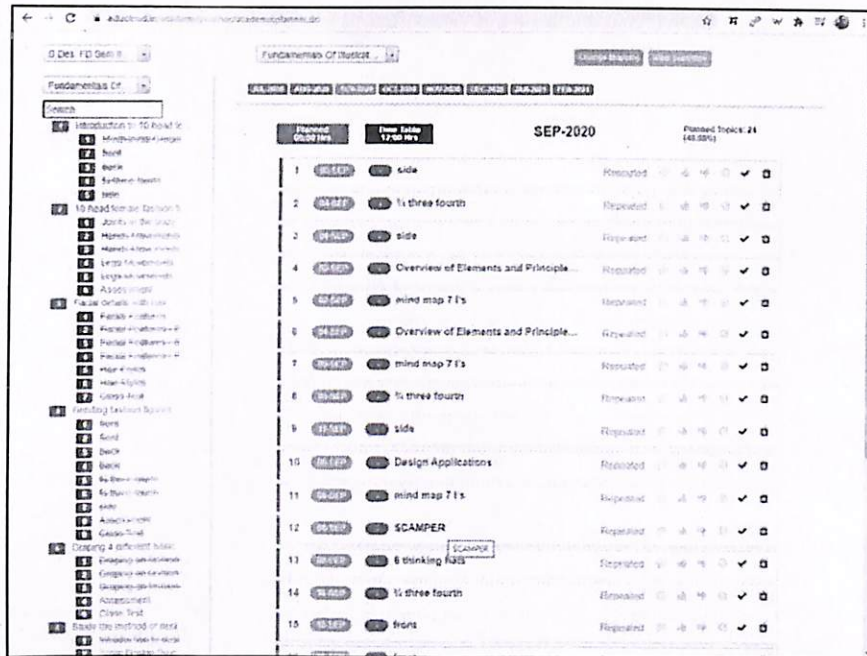

- Class CR and other academic post-election can be done digitally.

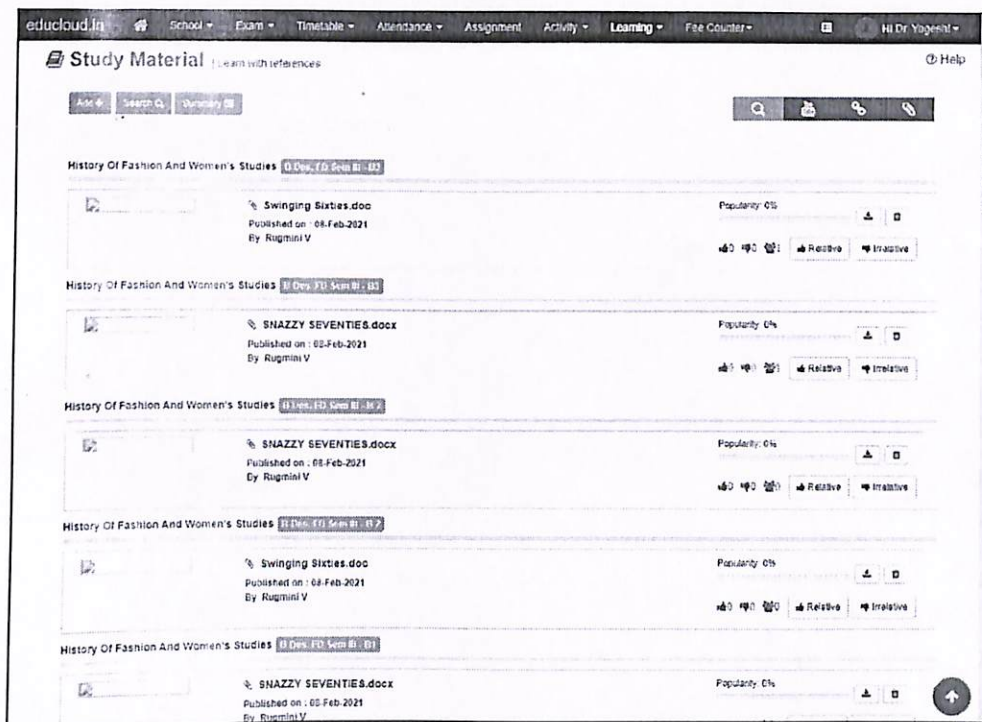
1. Assignments analytics for faculty on Educloud LMS system



2. Academic planner for Faculty on Educloud LMS system.

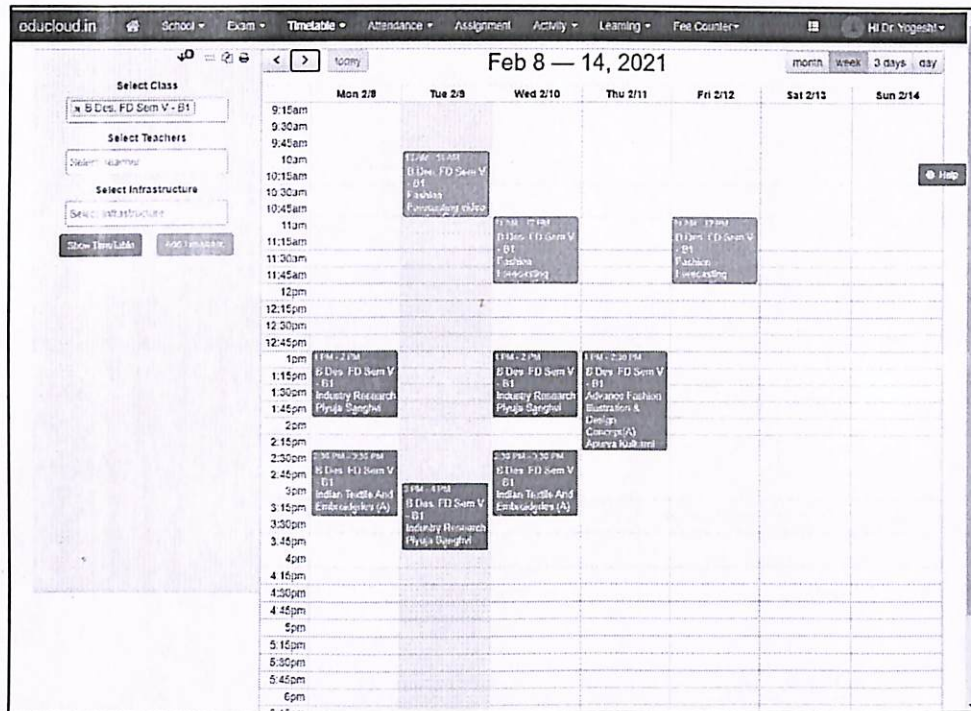


3. Study Material of various subjects on Educloud LMS system

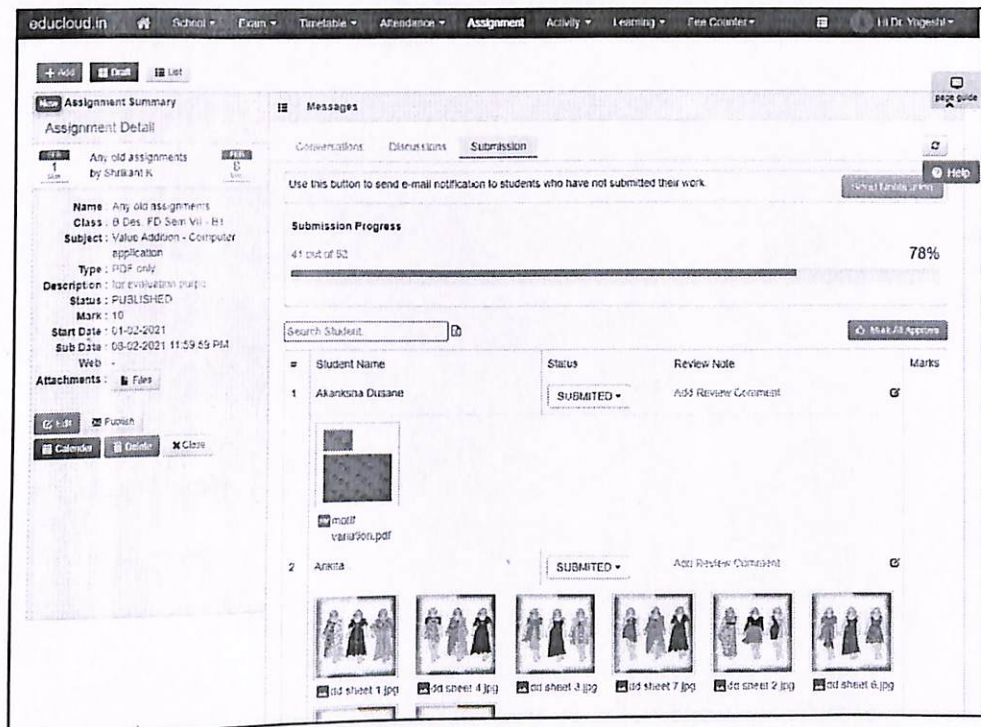


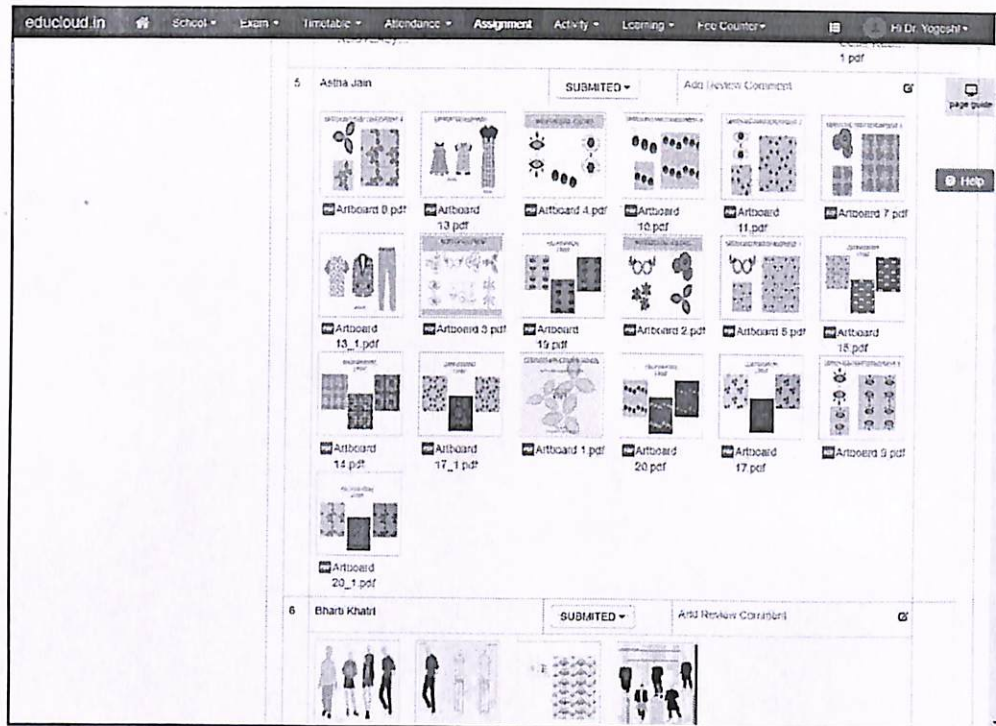
4. Student Timetable on LMS

Example - Student timetable on ERP system for various subjects.

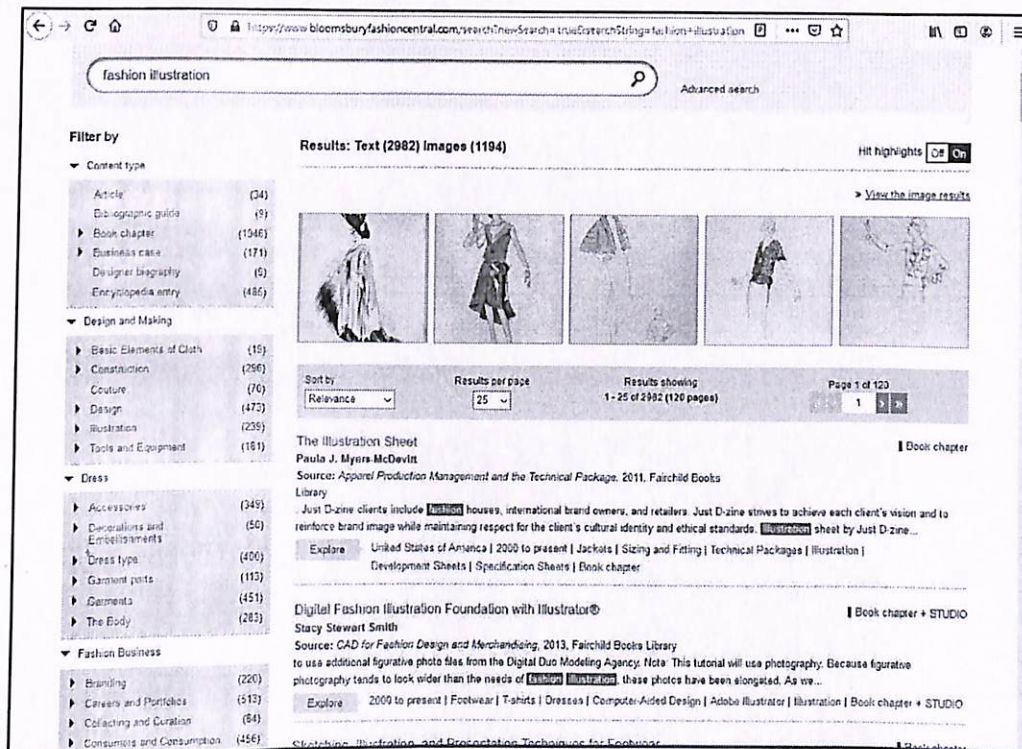

SOFT has conducted an online COMMON ENTRANCE TEST (CET) for Autonomous & University affiliated courses.

A student shall fulfil the eligibility criteria prescribed by the SNDT Women's University, Mumbai for enrolling in the CET(Common Entrance Exam) conducted by SOFT, Pune. As specified by the SNDT Women's University, Mumbai in academic council, the affiliated colleges may conduct common entrance tests at their own level. The admission of the student shall be made on the basis of her merit in the said entrance test. The common entrance test has prescribed three Criterias (tests) like general aptitude test, situation test and personal interview and it is mandatory for the student to appear for the same. The merit list will be based on all three criteria.
