Green audit is as potential tool which is used effectively by an educational institution for resource usage identification and optimization.

There exist Greenery plantations around the campus. One Project namely Craft Village is also available in campus to initiate craft practices by using natural resources and different plants. Different fabric colours are also produced by using different plants available in campus. College is also conducting Green Fashion Conference to initiate handmade different fabric product by Artisans all over India. Phulkari from Punjab, Paithani from Maharashtra, Pitloom, bandhani, suf from Bhuj Gujrat, Sangner from Rajsthan are some examples of it.

Under a variety of Sustainable practices in Learning, students are asked to bring their old clothes to turn them into new products. Waste generated from Fabrics for e.g. Muslin cloth used for rough stitching is used for making products in Surface techniques such as patch work and Strips that are further used for weaving and creating surfaces.
