#### **Minutes of the meeting :**

##### **1) Admission Update.**

Discussion on the updates of Admission 2020-21 updates and road forward amidst COVID pandemic.

LMC was given an update of the Admissions till date. S.N.D.T. Wing Admissions were 162 till 21<sup>st</sup> July. 13 Girls took the admission and left the college.

In Autonomous 17 Admissions were confirmed out of which 10 students have paid the money.

For the Autonomous courses, Jewellery Design and M. Design promotion, LMC approved the Company Works for Social Media promotion till September 2020.

## **2) Atal Community Innovation Center Application Updates.**

Updates about the ACIC application which is to be submitted to Government of India on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2020.

CDC was given the updates that MKSSS's SOFT was submitting the proposal to Government of India on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2020.

CDC was also informed that Entrepreneurship shall be considered as priority and should be incorporated in as a part of Value Addition to the regular courses.

Especially Craft Entrepreneurship shall be promoted amongst present students and Aluminae.

## **3) Mou with Banasthali Vidyapeeth**

Update Regarding Academic Excellence and Collaborative Research.

Banasthali is a Women's University in Jaipur and operates on similar grounds as Maharshi Karve Stree Shikshan Samstha. Banasthali University has been associated with MKSSS's SOFT for many years through participation in SOFT's Activities like Green Fashion India etc. With this reference Dr. M.M.Hundekar and Ms. Garima Bhalla visited the Banasthali University with the intention of exploring opportunities in the academic performance, teaching learning and Research areas and more meaningful association. Through an official meeting attended by Head of Department, Department of Design, Principal Dr. Hundekar, HOD Ms. Garima Bhalla and other faculties of Banasthali University.

The points discussed in the meeting were as follows:

- I. Inter Institution visits of Faculties for devising specific plans department wise.
- II. Exploration of joint activities related to projects, researches, publications.

III. Exploration of Inter Institutional Faculty meetings for future planning.

It was mutually decided that individual Institutions will seek permission from respective Statutory Bodies. With this background, LMC instructed that there should not be any monetary liability associated with the MOU. LMC suggested to invite few dignitaries, Director or faculties of Banasthali University to visit MKSS's SOFT. The hospitality shall be taken care by SOFT. The Draft MOU is attached herewith. The Final detailed MOU should be presented in the LMC.

#### **4) Major and Minor Projects.**

The University Grants Commission strives to promote teaching and research in emerging areas. These areas disciplines need to be studied and researched in a more organized manner. Institutionalization of such activities is a need of the present times.

To promote excellence in research in higher education by supporting research programmes of University and College teachers in various disciplines is the main objective of the Government funded Major and Minor Projects.

SOFT already has secured the 12B2F Documentation and is eligible for such funds if funds are available in these areas. With this background LMC suggested that respective departments should look into the Major and Minor Project areas applicable and shall be reviewed in the upcoming LMC.

#### **5) Strategic Planning regarding Online education and Classroom education.**

Discussion and approval for the strategic planning for the online sessions and Classroom Teaching (Practical) for future batches of students.

LMC suggested to do an in-depth research of the existing facilities like the projectors, Internet Connection etc. which can be useful for conducting online classes. Revised list and report of modalities of conduction of online teaching and college opening shall be presented in the next LMC.

LMC also suggested to give the responsibility of online education in charge to Dr. Yogesh Bokil.

LMC suggested to contact SMART college for preparation Online Videos/Content.

**6) Hygiene and Sanitation at workplace.**

The Hygiene and Sanitation of SOFT workplace should be done according to MKSSS Samstha guidelines.

**7) Exam Updates of S.N.D.T. Women's University.**


Exam updates regarding the 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> Year Exams of S.N.D.T. University


As per the SNTD university directives the final marking for the students is to be done as 50% internal evaluation and 50% previous semester marks.
